Clematis climbing vine

Beautiful climbing vines filled with flowers that bloom summer into fall. Our selections are all largeflowered varieties of different colors.

They need at least 6 hours of sun per day, in a place with good air flow around them (not crowded among other tall plants). They also like cool roots, so mulch or a ground cover around their base is important. You might want to amend the planting hole, as they like

rich, well-drained soil. Also plan on some sort of support (trellis, fence, or pole).



Oriental Lily bulbs

These lilies are known for dramatic large flowers and strong fragrance. They bloom late summer. We ordered a "mix", so you won't know what you have until they bloom.

They do best in full sun although they will tolerate a little shade. They like enriched soil. Most importantly, they require a well-drained area to avoid rotting bulbs. The shipped packaging recommended planting at 6 inches deep, and the website recommended spacing them out 8 to 10 inches from each other. They should multiply!

Full disclosure: The ordering website stated mature height at 4 feet, but I must tell you that the packaging on the bulbs when they arrived said "grows up to 8 feet." You won't know what you have until they grow!
