Communications Process and Content Guidelines

Communications to the entire membership shall be sent by the communications team only. Any committee or member wishing to send email to the entire group should request the communications team's assistance. The communications team can be reached by email at gxcentralmass@gmail.com

Any communication to the entire group should be:

- Gardening related
- Membership related (events, dues, member life events with appropriate permission obtained by requestor)

Communication to the entire group should not include content about politics, fundraising for outside causes or topics unrelated to gardening.

Free community events of interest to gardeners may be submitted for possible inclusion in our email newsletter.

The communications team will assess the appropriateness of any request for communication to the group. If the content is deemed inappropriate, it will be returned with a brief explanation.

Please submit items at least one month in advance.

Privacy and Opting Out of certain communications

The Gardeners Exchange will not sell or share our membership list to outside organizations.

The membership list is provided for individual members to communicate with other individual members. The membership list is NOT to be used for mass mailings or solicitation by any member. If a member has something to send to the group, they should request the communications team send it.
